What's involved in an Arboricultural Asset Management Contract?

Typically covering a 3 year period, a contract includes the following elements:

Initial setup	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Initial Tree Inventory & Risk Assessment The identification of every significant tree on your property and a Quantitative Tree Risk Assessment (QTRA) to measure their risk to people and property. A written report generated from our findings outlines the work needed and is prioritised by risk level.2. Initial tree care and maintenance Once your trees have been cataloged and assessed, our trained and certified arborists will conduct the work exactly to the specifications.
Ongoing Monitoring	<ol style="list-style-type: none">3. Annual update of the Inventory & Risk Assessment In the subsequent years, the Tree Inventory and Risk Assessment are updated to reflect the conditions of your trees and current risk levels.4. Annual tree care and maintenance Annual maintenance is required to maintain your assets in a safe and healthy state. Once again, work will be done based on the priorities identified by the risk assessment. As risk is reduced this allows for proactive management and tree care.
